SUMMER VISITATION STRATEGY

- ⇒ For the next several weeks, **this is our priority!**
 - The summer gives us a window of opportunity that we must take advantage of.

- ⇒ Our goals:
 - Spend quality time promoting this on Sunday mornings. (*You can neglect the rest.*)
 - Lead by example and be here!
 - Work hard to bring your class members with you.
- ⇒ What about the rest of Sunday School visitation?
 - Goal: Designate 2 hours a week for visitation work (that is 1% of your week).
 - Set aside Monday night for the Summer Visitation Program 6:30-8:00 (1.5 hours).
 - Reserve 30 minutes to work your class primarily by phone.
 - (Obviously, when other things come up you may need to adjust but this is a workable strategy for the summer months.)
