Here are some practical steps to set goals in a way that aligns with Scripture:

- 1. Start with Prayer (James 1:5; Proverbs 16:3)
 - a. Begin the goal-setting process by seeking God's guidance.
 - b. Ask for wisdom and discernment to understand His will for your life.
 - c. Commit your plans to the Lord.
- 2. Align Goals with God's Will (Ephesians 5:17)
 - a. Ensure that your goals are in harmony with biblical principles.
 - b. As Matthew 6:33 advises, seek first God's kingdom and righteousness.
 - c. The question is not, "Where do I want to lead my class?" The question is, "Where is God leading my class?"

3. Write Your Goals (Habakkuk 2:2-3)

- a. Habakkuk 2:2-3 encourages making plans clear and visible.
- b. Make them tangible.
- c. This is the process that will help you crystallize your thinking.
- 4. Be Specific and Realistic (Luke 14:28)
 - a. Set clear, achievable goals.
 - b. Luke 14:28 illustrates the importance of planning and estimating costs before starting a project.
- 5. Develop a **Strategy**
 - a. Break down your goals into actionable steps.
 - b. Plan what you need to do daily, weekly, and monthly to achieve your objectives.
- 6. Remain **Humble** and **Flexible** (James 4:13-15)
 - a. While setting goals is important, maintain humility and flexibility.
 - b. As James 4:13-15 teaches, recognize that ultimately, God determines our steps.
- 7. Evaluate **Regularly** (see Nehemiah at the half-way point)
 - a. Periodically review your goals and progress.
 - b. Reflect on whether they still align with God's will and adjust as necessary.
- 8. **Persevere** with Confidence (Hebrews 10:35-36)
 - a. Hebrews 10:35-36 encourages perseverance in doing God's will.
 - b. Stay committed to your goals, trusting in God's guidance.
