BEAT THE HEAT STRATEGY: WORK IT!!!

WORKING SUNDAY SCHOOL INTENTIONALLY (OR SYSTEMATICALLY)

- ⇒ Principle: Your success on Sunday will be the result of your efforts Monday through Saturday.
- ⇒ We are commanded to go: Acts 20:20; Matthew 25:36
- \Rightarrow There are two types of visits:
 - Urgent: These are the on-going needs of the class that cannot be neglected. Ministry visits, absentee visits, first-time guest visits, evangelism visits, etc.
 - Systematic: The work that makes sure that each person that we are assigned responsibility for has been touched.
- ⇒ Every teacher should have a goal: To sit down one-on-one with EVERY member assigned to their care and have a meaningful spiritual conversation every year (at least).
 - Review their salvation; check up on their spiritual temperature; see how you can encourage them to grow closer to the Lord, etc.
 - Create a chart and simply work down the chart, checking people off as you spend time with them.

LEADING LIKE JESUS

- 1. Jesus modeled full dependence on the Holy Spirit.
- 2. Jesus modeled the centrality of **prayer** in His life and ministry.
- 3. Jesus modeled the importance of **obedience** to His Father's will.
- 4. God's Word was central in His life and ministry.
- 5. Jesus consistently modeled the pattern of **exalting** His Father in every area of life.
- 6. Jesus modeled intentional relationships of love and integrity throughout His life.
