⇒ POINT: As disciples, we all have a responsibility to “show and tell.” Personal evangelism must be a priority.

## BIBLE STUDY:

1. The Call for \_\_\_\_\_ Disciples

- a. There are five Great Commission statements in the New Testament. God’s plan is comprehensive.
  - i. The \_\_\_\_\_ (Matthew 28:18-20)
  - ii. The \_\_\_\_\_ (John 20:21)
  - iii. The \_\_\_\_\_ (Mark 16:15)
  - iv. The \_\_\_\_\_ (Luke 24:47)
  - v. The \_\_\_\_\_ (Acts 1:8)
- b. We have been given everything we need to understand and to carry out the mission. The only choice we must make is whether or not we will obey.

2. The Call to \_\_\_\_\_ (Matthew 5:14-16)

- a. We must have a testimony that supports that the Gospel has changed our lives.
- b. Jesus says that His followers are to be lights in a dark world.
  - i. Vs. 14 – Our light should be \_\_\_\_\_. (“Cannot be hid...”)
  - ii. Vs. 15 – Our light should be \_\_\_\_\_. (“Giveth light unto all...”)
  - iii. Vs. 16 – Our light should \_\_\_\_\_ the Father. (“glorify your Father...”)
- c. The difference that Jesus has made in our lives should be obvious to those that are around us. Our testimony should point others to Jesus.

3. The Call to \_\_\_\_\_ (Romans 10:14-17)

- a. Too many Christians think that all they have to do is live a “good Christian life” and there is no real responsibility to tell others about Jesus. Paul didn’t believe that!
- b. Notice the process of the Gospel (vs. 14-15).
  - i. Calling requires \_\_\_\_\_: “How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed?”
  - ii. Believing requires \_\_\_\_\_: “And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard?” People must hear the Gospel!
  - iii. Hearing requires \_\_\_\_\_: “And how shall they hear without a preacher?” For someone to hear, someone must tell!

- iv. Preaching requires \_\_\_\_\_: “And how shall they preach, except they be sent?” Someone must go!
- c. Paul summarizes the principle in verse 17:
  - i. Faith’s source: “So then faith cometh by hearing”
  - ii. The content of what is heard: “And hearing by the word of God.”
  - iii. To believe, one must hear. And for one to hear, someone else must tell.
- d. APPLICATION: Who do you need to tell? Who has God put in your life who need to hear the Gospel? Review your class “Come & See” list.
